## WSU Course Designation Amendment

"Students may take as many WSU courses as they wish, but only the non-overlapping GE attributes from subsequent WSU courses will count toward GE requirements. For example, a student who passes WSU 1560 (SS/HU) completes SS and HU attributes in her GE requirements. If she then passes WSU 1680 (SS/PS), she will complete only the non-overlapping PS attributes in her GE requirements."
