ADMISSIONS, STANDARDS AND STUDENT AFFAIRS

PPM 1-13, Article 5, Section 4.2: The Admissions, Standards and Student Affairs Committee shall be concerned with standards for admission, retention and graduation from the University and policies pertaining to student affairs

1. Finalize a proposed addendum to PPM 6-22 regarding military students and faculty responsibilities for excused military absences.
2. Disseminate information gathered in 2015-2016 regarding recommendations to increase retention and graduation rates of first time, full time students.
3. Review a proposed addendum to PPM 4-1III regarding requirements for institutional certificates.
4. Consider revising PPM 4-21a to be congruent with the new USHE agreement that requires institutions to grant 18 hours of credit to officers that complete Police Officer Standardized Training (POST).
5. Provide recommendations of ways that faculty could be more effective in student advising, including interfacing with new institutional advising software to increase student retention and graduation rates.
6. Review a proposed amendment to PPM 9-4IIA to recommend faculty include provisions in their syllabi for the continuation of a face-to-face or hybrid course, in the case of an emergency, that prevents classes from being held on site.
7. Review a proposed addendum to PPM 4-1 that would include a 45 day processing time period from the degree conferral date.
