ADMISSIONS, STANDARDS AND STUDENT AFFAIRS

PPM 1-13, Article 5, Section 4.2: The Admissions, Standards and Student Affairs Committee shall be concerned with standards for admission, retention and graduation from the University and policies pertaining to student affairs

- 1. Finalize a proposed addendum to PPM 6-22 regarding military students and faculty responsibilities for excused military absences.
- 2. Disseminate information gathered in 2015-2016 regarding recommendations to increase retention and graduation rates of first time, full time students.
- 3. Review a proposed addendum to PPM 4-1III regarding requirements for institutional certificates.
- 4. Consider revising PPM 4-21a to be congruent with the new USHE agreement that requires institutions to grant 18 hours of credit to officers that complete Police Officer Standardized Training (POST).
- 5. Provide recommendations of ways that faculty could be more effective in student advising, including interfacing with new institutional advising software to increase student retention and graduation rates.
- 6. Review a proposed amendment to PPM 9-4IIA to recommend faculty include provisions in their syllabi for the continuation of a face-to-face or hybrid course, in the case of an emergency, that prevents classes from being held on site.
- 7. Review a proposed addendum to PPM 4-1 that would include a 45 day processing time period from the degree conferral date.
