Goals and Objectives

Each year, the Research, Scholarship, and Professional Growth Committee reviews proposals in several categories:

- Fall Term
 - Hemingway Faculty Vitality (\$10,000)
 - Instructional Improvement Research (\$15,000)
- Spring Term
 - Travel Stipends (see below)
 - Hemingway Collaborative and Excellence Awards (\$45,000)
 - Hemingway Faculty Vitality (\$10,000)
 - Hemingway Adjunct Faculty (\$4,000)
 - Hemingway New Faculty (\$20,000)
 - Instructional Improvement and Research (\$15,000)
 - Community Engaged Learning (\$10,000)

During the 2016-2017 academic year, we received funding requests for \$159,227 and awarded \$144,622 in funding. Departments and Colleges pledged matching funds of \$173,741, for a total \$318,363 to promote faculty growth and professional development in this academic year.

Additional Work

This year (Spring 2017) we instituted rolling travel stipend deadlines, including a simplified proposal form. This funding came from RSPG and Hemingway Vitality funding. We awarded \$1000 (or cost of travel) to applicants on a first come, first served basis. As result, we awarded 20 stipends (\$17,743), reserving the remaining funding for early fall applicants. We also combined the two spring deadlines into one and streamlined the application process.

Future Work

We plan to continue the rolling travel stipends into the fall term. This summer we will look at the proposal forms to see how they can be improved.
